GIRLS UNIFORM POLICY Grades K-8

Revised August 2016

JUMPERS/SKIRTS/SKORTS

- Uniform plaid or navy blue; 100% cotton or cotton/polyester blend
Students in grs. 6-8 may wear khaki skirts. (No denim)
- Slacks, sweat/athletic pants may not be worn under skirts or jumpers during the school day.*
- Skirt and jumper length may be no shorter than 1 inch above the knee.
- Pencil style skirts are not allowed.
- Skorts may be worn during the winter months with leggings or tights.

**Girls may wear sweat/athletic pants under their jumper/skirts/skorts only during recess on cold days*

BLOUSES

- Solid white or light blue cotton, turtleneck or collared shirt
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear pastel yellow or navy blue blouses.
- Capped, pocket sleeves or sleeveless shirts are not allowed.
- Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in.
- Shirts must be tucked in, gr. 3-8.
- The only logo permitted is *Saint Brigid Catholic School*.

SWEATERS

- Solid navy blue or solid white cardigan, sweater vest or pullover sweater.
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear a gray sweater.
- Zip up cardigan/hooded sweater, fleece, or sweatshirt are considered outdoor wear and may not be worn in class.
- Belted sweaters are not allowed.
- The only sweatshirt allowed is with the *Saint Brigid Catholic School* logo.

SLACKS

- Navy blue 100% cotton, cotton/polyester blend, or corduroy dress pants.
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear khaki slacks.
- Jeans, cargo style pants, denim or stretch material are not allowed.
- Bell bottoms, stirrups, knit or stretch pants are not allowed.
- Slacks must be ankle length and loose fitting.

SHORTS/CAPRIS (April 1–October 31 only)

- Navy blue 100% cotton or cotton/polyester blends.
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear khaki shorts.
- Jean, cargo style and athletic shorts are not allowed.
- Uniform shorts may be worn during gym class throughout the year. (K-5)
- Gym students in gr. 6-8, athletic shorts must be the same length as or longer than uniform shorts.

BELTS

- Students in grs. K-3 *may* wear pants/shorts without a belt.
- Students in grs. 4-8 *must* wear a belt with pants and shorts that have belt loops.
- Belts must be plain, solid navy blue, black or brown.
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear khaki belts.

FOOTWEAR

- Socks must be worn at all times, grs. K-8.
- Solid white, navy blue, crew socks, knee highs or tights are permitted.
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear khaki socks.
- Nylons, knee socks, tights of white or navy blue must be worn on Mass days, grs. 6-8
- Students must wear black, navy blue or brown dress shoes on Mass days, grs. 3-8

FOOTWEAR CON'T

- Gym/athletic shoes with non-marking soles are allowed at all other times.
- Light up shoes are not allowed.
- Sandals, clogs or flip flops and fashion boots are not allowed.
- Heels for all shoes should be 1" or less.

HAIR

- Headscarves, bandanas, and hats/caps may not be worn in school.
- Headbands must be uniform plaid, navy blue, white, brown or black.
- Other colors not allowed.
- Unnatural hair colors are not permitted at school.
- Hairstyles may not cover a student's eyes.

JEWELRY

- A simple cross and chain or religious medal is permitted.
- A simple ring is allowed.
- A wristwatch is permitted.
- Earrings are not permitted.
- One bracelet is allowed, grs. 3-8. (not on Mass days)
- Temporary tattoos or writing on self is not allowed.

NON UNIFORM DAYS

- On days which are designated Jean Day, guidelines will be announced. If a student chooses not to participate in the spirit of the day, then the student must wear the school uniform.
- Spaghetti straps, tank tops and halter tops are not allowed.
- Sandals, clogs or flip flops and fashion boots are not allowed.
- Heels for all shoes should be 1" or less.
- Light up shoes are not allowed.
- Gym shorts and athletic pants are not allowed.
- Jeans and cargo shorts are allowed
- Skirts/dresses are allowed if they are no shorter than 1-inch above the knee

FIELD TRIPS

- Uniforms must be worn on field trips, unless other apparel is designated by the teacher.

MASS ATTIRE

- In grs. K-2, may wear uniform shorts (April 1-October 31).
- In grs. 3-8, jumper or skirt is required.
- In grs. 3-8, students must wear black, navy blue or brown dress shoes.
- In grs. 3-8, girls are allowed to wear the uniform plaid ties, but only with a button down dress shirt- not a polo shirt. The office will not lend out uniform ties.
- In grs. 6-8, nylons, knee socks, tights of white or navy blue must be worn.

CONSEQUENCES

Consequences for students, who do not adhere to the Uniform Policy, could include a phone call to the parents requesting they provide appropriate clothing for the day. Students who are not in uniform may be denied a ministry at Mass. Middle School students will receive an automatic demerit if they are not in uniform on mass days.

All uniform clothing may be purchased from either *Schoolbelles* or *French Toast*. If you choose to purchase uniform clothing from other companies, they must conform to our uniform policy.
