When will Junior Science take place?

*There will be 2 sessions this year. **Session One** will focus on Chemistry, Biology and Physics. It will be open to students in grades 4, 5, and 6. The class will be in the science lab from 3:30-4:45 each Monday and Thursday. Session One will take place from October 1 through November 8. **Session Two** will focus on Chemistry and Physics. Those classes will be January 7 through February 21 on the same days and times as session one. Students in grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 may register for Session Two.*
