

ALUMNI PROFILE MARY EPPLE 1948-1956

Mary Epple, RSM, attended Saint Brigid Catholic School from 1948 to 1956. She graduated from St. Mary's Bay City in 1960. She entered the Sisters of Mercy in 1960 and took her final vows in 1968. She graduated from Mercy College of Detroit in 1965 and Marygrove College with a Masters of Education in 1977.

She taught first grade at St. Mary's in Independence, Indiana and in Bay City before returning to Saint Brigid in Midland to teach first grade. Sister Mary Epple held numerous religious roles throghout her life including Director of Education in Zilwaukee, Michigan, Vocations Director of Saginaw Diocese, Pastoral Minister at St. Hyacinth in Bay City, and helped merge five parishes on the east side of the Saginaw, Michigan. She is now retired and lives in East Lansing, MI.

Sister Mary Epple has volunteered with CROP Walk in Bay and Saginaw County and has done prayer services in Bay and Saginaw County jails.

One of her favorite memories was in eighth grade when Sister Mary Nolaco, RSM, directed the class in the production of the Gilbert and Sullivan opera, MIKADO.
