

SAINT BRIGID CATHOLIC SCHOOL BOYS' UNIFORM POLICY Grades K-8

SHIRTS

- Solid white or light blue cotton, turtleneck or collared shirt
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear pastel yellow or navy blue shirts. (No denim)
- Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in.
- Shirts must be tucked in, grs. 3-8.
- The only logo permitted is *Saint Brigid Catholic School*.

SWEATERS

- Solid navy blue or solid white cardigan, sweater vest or pullover sweater.
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear a gray sweater.
- Navy blue/gray/green fleeces embroidered with the *Saint Brigid Catholic School* logo are permitted in class but not in church.
- Green and white embroidered *Saint Brigid Catholic School* sweatshirt is permitted in class but not in church. All other hooded and zip up sweatshirts are not permitted.

PANTS

- Navy blue, 100% cotton, cotton/polyester blend, or corduroy dress pants
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear khaki pants.
- Jeans, cargo style pants, denim or stretch material are not allowed.
- Pants must be ankle length and loose fitting.

SHORTS (April 1– October 31 only or by permission of school)

- Navy blue 100% cotton or cotton/polyester blends.
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear khaki shorts.
- Jean, cargo style and athletic shorts are not allowed.
- Gym students in grs. 6-8, may change into appropriate athletic apparel for class.

BELTS

- Students in grs. K-3 may wear pants/shorts without a belt.
- Students in grs. 4-8 *must* wear a belt with pants and shorts that have belt loops.
- Belts must be solid colored; navy blue, black, or brown.
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear khaki belts.

FOOTWEAR

- Socks of solid color, white, brown, black, or navy blue must be worn at all times.
- Students in grs. 6-8 may also wear khaki socks.
- Gym/athletic shoes with non-marking soles are allowed at all other times.
- Sandals, clogs and flip flops are not allowed.

HAIR & HYGIENE

- Hats/caps may not be worn in school.
- Unnatural hair colors are not permitted at school.
- Hair must be collar length or shorter.
- Hairstyles may not cover a student's eyes.
- Temporary tattoos or writing on self is not allowed.

MASS ATTIRE

- In grs. K-2, may wear uniform shorts (April 1-October 31).
- In grs. 3-8, a white or light blue button-down dress shirt is required. Rolled up sleeves are not allowed during mass.
- In grs. 3-8, must wear black, navy blue, or brown dress shoes.
- In grs. 3-8, must wear slacks.
- In grs. 3-8, must wear green plaid uniform ties. The office will not lend out uniform ties. Uniform plaid ties are available for purchase in the school office.

NON-UNIFORM DAY

- On days which are designated "non-uniform days", guidelines will be announced. If a student chooses not to participate in the spirit of the day, then the student must wear the school uniform.
- Clothing must be modest and appropriate and follow the guidelines of the spirit day (if specified).
- Sleeveless shirts and tank tops are not allowed.
- Sandals, clogs and flip flops are not allowed.

FIELD TRIPS

Uniforms must be worn on field trips, unless other apparel is designated by the teacher.

Consequences for students, who do not adhere to the Uniform Policy, could include a phone call to the parents requesting they provide appropriate clothing for the day. Students who are not in uniform may be denied a ministry at Mass. Middle School students will receive an automatic demerit if they are not in uniform on mass days.

All uniform clothing may be purchased from either *Schoolbelles* or *French Toast*.

If you choose to purchase uniform clothing from other companies, they must conform to our uniform policy.
