- Playground updated by grants from local Foundations



\*INCOME: our 'other income' had two major components, an early distribution of \$70,000 from the Ray Cones estate, an unexpected blessing, many other one time donations made by parishioners and federal monies received as a result of CoVid legislation.


\*\*EXPENSE: inflation is real, as you can see our cost of operations have increased due to rising energy, salaries and benefits. We also had many pass-through grants which resulted in monies received for projects and investments in the school as a result of CoVid recovery funds.

\*\*\*PTO FUNDRAISING has three buckets: The Emerald Evening Fundraiser which resulted in \$220,854, the Guardian Angel Move-a-thon, and the remainder a result of SCRIP program.

\*\*\*\* NET DEFICIT: \$180,000 from the Therese Nowak estate was added to the James Cardinal Hickey Endowment so that her generosity will never be exhausted. The funds were received at the end of the 2020-21 fiscal year so this year they appear as an investment and explain the overall deficit for the current year. Thank you for your support as we seek to endow \$1,000,000 through the Sustaining Our Lives in Christ initiative.

God's blessings cannot be numbered; in the last 5 years with the faith of parish members like you, the hard work of our PTO, and some well-timed legacy gifts, our parish finances have been transformed and we are able to plan for the next century of Catholic Education. Thank you for your sacrificial giving to our needs. CoVid relief monies will once again play a positive force in the 2022-23 budget year. This is the last year we will have those funds and future budgets will only balance if we can grow our collection and donations revenue. Now is a great time to examine the overall giving trends of our parish and discern if you can increase your gifts so we are able to pay justly and maintain our historic campus.

NET INCREASE / (DECREASE) IN CASH






#### 2021-2022 Saint Brigid Catholic School State of the School

This year has gone by so quickly! It was great to be able to get back to normal again! And even with the end of year hiccup with COVID cases, we have resumed previous year's activities and even started some new events.



- We welcomed 18 new families into our school community as well as two new staff members.
- Our enrollment was up this year to 137 students.
- We created a Reading Specialist/Assistant Principal combined role.
- Our NWEA scores continue to outperform the Diocese and State averages in almost all subject areas
- We implemented a new science of reading program complete with sound walls in grades K-1 that show great promise- look at the test scores for starters!
- Received a "Do the Math" tutoring program which we are slowly implementing
- LeAnne Osborn taught Catechesis of the Good Shepherd for grades K-2. Jennifer Winberg started a weekly preschool Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program as well.
- LeAnne Osborn taught Middle School Theology and provided religion guidance to elementary teachers.
- Bailey Brown helped our Fully Alive program to get back on track with Whole Family Catechesis Program.
- We made our first increase in tuition in 10 years to accommodate rising costs to educate our children.
